<u>Motor Lab</u> – The Motor Lab is a centralized location where qualifying students come to participate in integrated sensory-motor intervention with a multidisciplinary team of therapists. The disciplines represented in the motor lab are Speech Therapy (ST), Occupational Therapy (OT) and Physical Therapy (PT). There is a continuous collaborative effort on the part of the disciplines and teaching staff to provide each child with a well-rounded, integrated therapeutic approach that facilitates student success in the educational setting.

During Motor Lab sessions each student progresses through a series of sensory-motor stations in which progress is continually monitored and activities are prescribed accordingly. This approach of working collaboratively in a multidisciplinary team increases awareness of each child's needs and abilities better enabling their success across all environments. Motor Lab therapists then work with the teaching staff to carry over necessary interventions into the classroom.

The students that are served in motor lab are those who demonstrate significant sensory and/or motor delays and whose involvement is not so severe in nature that they cannot participate in the physical demands of the motor lab. Participation in the program is determined by a multidisciplinary team that reviews each student's individual needs. For a student to participate written parental permission and a medical referral clearing them for therapy must be obtained. Students who qualify are bused to Travis Family and Student Education Center where the motor lab is located.
